Venue: Tech. Lab.

1. Number of participants will be two per school.
2. Time duration for the event will be two and half hours.
3. Only the first 20 confirming teams will be allowed to participate.
4. Only the teams, which qualify in the preliminary round (written round for 45 minutes) will go for the final round. (Only 8 TEAMS)
5. Project for programming will be given on the spot.
6. Software to be used : Turbo C Editor
7. Teams are not allowed to bring any hard or soft copy of any material of any sort.

PENTATHLON

Class : IX-XII

30th August, 2007

Venue: Maitri Hall

The Pentathlon in the annual ATF will showcase a broad spectrum of talent of enterprising students from schools of Delhi.

The Pentathlon will consist of the following events:

- I. Extempore- "Mercury Rising"
- II. Pantomime
- III. Mini Fashion Show "Green Couture"
- IV. Poetry Writing Competition "Cry Of The Wild"
- V. Go Green Ad- Mad Way

1. Each school will send a team of 12 members who will necessarily represent their respective school in all the events of the Pentathlon from Class IX to XII
2. A team member can participate in maximum of 2 events only.
3. Each event will have a certain number of points assigned to it for the 1st 6 positions. The team/school securing the maximum number of points will be awarded the trophy for the Pentathlon.
4. The order of participation in each event will be determined by draw of lots..

1. The group will select its own situation and subject etc.
2. A short narration may be given to introduce the idea.
3. Number of participants is 3 to 4
4. The group must make its own arrangements for music. However the host school will provide the plug point ,player and amplifier.
5. There will be no vocalization.
6. Time limit is 3 minutes on and off the stage.
7. No classical dance form is acceptable.

Criteria for judgment: Enactment of theme, Synchronization of music with actions,



EVENT-3

MINI FASHION SHOW "GREEN COUTURE"

30TH August,2007

The event will showcase eco friendly accessories.

1. Only one team comprising of 6 participants is allowed from each school.
2. The teams may give a name to their group.
3. The teams will be given 3 minutes to perform which will include a brief introduction.
4. All accessories must be made of Eco-friendly materials.
5. Participants should bring their own music & make-up etc. for the event.
6. Modesty and decorum must be maintained.
7. Students may be questioned by the judges.

Criteria for judgment : Originality of the accessory , Viability of the product , Presentation and the Impact of the message.

Dear Friends,

Never, in its entire history of 5 million years, has mankind faced such a real and present threat to its existence as it has today. Climate change and its after effects are no longer an academic issue, worthy of drawing room debates and scientific interest, but is a real danger to the existence of our planet Earth.

The atmospheric concentration of carbon dioxide (CO₂) has increased by 31% since 1750. The present CO₂ concentration is more than what happened during the past 420,000 years and very likely more than that of the past 20 million years. The other major agents of adverse change are Methane (CH₄) gases which have grown 151% in the last 200 years and contribute to a third of the damage, followed by CFC gases and Nitrous Oxide (N₂O). About three-quarters of emissions of CO₂ to the atmosphere during the past 20 years is due to fossil fuel burning. The rest is predominantly due to land (ab)use change, especially deforestation. Sadly ¾ of the present damage is anthropogenic, i.e. man made, or caused by human usage. The matter is further being confounded by large scale deforestation as an easy solution to modern urbanization needs, that require felling more and more trees for larger and more luxurious condos.

Since 1995, the atmospheric concentrations of many of those halocarbon gases (CFCs) that are both ozone-depleting and greenhouse gases (e.g., CFC₃ and CF₂Cl₂), are either increasing more slowly or decreasing, as a response to reduced emissions under the regulations of the Montreal Protocol and its Amendments. Their substitute compounds (e.g., CHF₂Cl and CF₃CH₂F) and some other synthetic compounds (e.g., perfluorocarbons (PFCs) and sulphur hexafluoride (SF₆)) are also greenhouse gases, and their concentrations are currently increasing.

The political ramifications are equally intriguing. Whereas the major emission is caused by the Group of 8 most powerful and richest nations of the world (G-8), they are reluctant to address the problem as radically as required and are demanding that Developing Nations comprising the Group of 15 (G-15) should take initiatives whereas the G-8, should be given more time to do it.

Our theme this year for the AGNEL TALENT FEST is focused on the idea of climate change as it is the most critical problem affecting the survival of the Planet. We are aiming at two objectives: to make students aware of the problems and seek opportunities to address the issue at all levels, in their schools, study groups, and to create in young people higher levels of interest in international issues, that affect us, but are largely left to Government agencies and scientists. Can we afford such luxury in view of this impending disaster waiting to happen?



Regulations to be followed by member countries:

1. Confirmation for participation should be made within a week.
2. The participating schools could send in their country preference.
3. Allotment of countries will be made on a first come first served basis and so schools may/may not get their country preference.
4. The schools will be notified of their allotted country as soon as the confirmation comes in.
5. Each school will send in a team of 12- 15 members. 6. As this is a debate between the G8 and G5 nations we close entries for participation on receiving confirmation letters from thirteen schools.

Module to be followed by each team:

1. All representatives of their allotted countries will march down the aisle of the auditorium to the stage displaying their placards, shouting slogans or any other form of peaceful protest..
2. The leader of the demonstrators will address the gathering from the podium.
3. The demonstrators are expected to participate actively in the debate by cheering the leader on, prompting the leader, adding an important point etc.
4. At the end of the debate the leader has to respond to an interjection by a representative of another country. Here again a fellow-demonstrator could prompt for, or add a point.

Criteria for judgment:

1. The March (includes slogans, placards, national costumes etc.)
2. The Debate (includes the leader's address and the active participation of the fellow demonstrators)
3. The Response (includes the leader's response to the points of interjection and/or prompting by a fellow demonstrator)
