- Students MUST come in school uniform.

Scoring System

There is a flat scoring system for all events:

- First Position : 100 points
- Second Position : 75 points
- Third Position : 50 points

Teams which register online through the Code Warriors' website and do not change their team composition on event days will get **42** bonus points.
